

HOME-SCHOOL COMPACT

To successfully educate a child, all adults involved in the child's life must fulfill specific responsibilities. The purpose of this document is to establish the basic responsibilities of administrators, teachers, and staff of Collegium Charter School (CCS), as well as those of parents/guardians. By recognizing and committing to the fulfillment of the responsibilities listed below, a positive working relationship can be established which will enhance the quality of education for all students. Please review this with your child.

It is the responsibility of Collegium administration, faculty, and staff to:

1. Provide a physically and emotionally safe learning environment.
2. Provide curriculum, instruction, and assessment that meet the needs of each student.
3. Communicate effectively with parents/guardians:
 - Contact parents with concerns and issues.
 - Respond in a timely fashion to parents/guardians.
 - Provide timely feedback regarding assessments.
 - Hold meaningful parent/teacher conferences.
4. Involve parents/guardians in the decisions that impact their children's education.
5. Fulfill obligations outlined within the CCS charter.

It is the responsibility of parents/guardians to:

1. Follow the school calendar.
2. Send children to school ready to learn with proper rest and nutrition.
3. Attend scheduled school conferences.
4. Read, review with their child, and support the *Student Code of Conduct*.
5. Review student's assignment books and assessments in a timely fashion.
6. Volunteer or assist the school in some way at least two hours per month.
7. Allow students to accept responsibility for their behavior and actions.
8. Contact the school to share thoughts, questions, or concerns.
9. Read and appropriately respond to school communications sent from school personnel.

It is the responsibility of students to:

1. Follow the *Student Code of Conduct*.
2. Give their best effort in their studies.
3. Arrive to class on time with appropriate materials.
4. Write all assignments in their assignment book.
5. Complete and return all assignments on time.
6. Contact an adult if they need assistance.
7. Conduct themselves and engage each other and school personnel with dignity and respect.
