Talent Show held on
Wednesday, June 7th at 6:00pm!

When are tryouts and how do I get there?

- Tryouts will be held on **Monday, April 24th in the 150 Cafeteria** and **Tuesday, April 25th in the 515 Auditorium.**
- Each student will be assigned a tryout time on one of the dates. Any student from a different building will be escorted to their tryout location. If your child is scheduled to try out in their own building, they will be called down at dismissal. Additionally, 7-12th grade students will be supervised at their location until tryouts begin.
- All students must be picked up **no later** than 6pm from the appropriate building.

What do I need to do to tryout?

- All entries must be performing arts. For space and safety reasons, gymnastics routines and karate demonstrations are not permitted. Additionally lip-synching entries will not be considered.
- **Any** performance (dance/singing etc.) that requires music must be turned in to Ms. Grandizio with their permission slip **no later than Thursday, April 20th.** NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.
- Students singing along to music must provide a CD with the karaoke (no-vocals) version. Please do not sing over the performers' voice on the CD. There will be no exceptions to this policy; **only** karaoke versions will be accepted and they must be provided to **Ms. Grandizio by Thursday, April 20th.**
- Any student wishing to tryout **must** return the attached permission slip by **Thursday, April 20th.** **No late slips will be accepted,** as tryout dates will be determined by the permission slips in hand on Thursday, April 20th.
- Review the Talent Show Rules (attached).

How will I know if I'm in the show?

- A list of accepted performances will be posted on Wednesday, April 26th in each building. Please note that due to time constraints only 25 acts (approximately) are able to be selected.

Okay, so I'm in the show, now what?

- There will be TWO rehearsals prior to the show. **Monday, June 5th and Tuesday June 6th,** both from 4-6pm in the 515 auditorium.
- Students in accepted performances **must** be available to attend **both** of the after school practices.
- Students must also be able to attend the Talent Show on **Wednesday, June 7th** and report in costume by 5:30pm

Talent Show Rules

- 1.) All students must meet the Extra-Curricular Eligibility Guidelines (academics, behavior and attendance) in order to be eligible to participate. Eligibility guidelines can be found in the Collegium Student Code of Conduct.
- 2.) Songs, costumes, and dance movements must be appropriate for the school environment. The show coordinators will review songs, costumes, and dance movements to determine appropriateness. Songs must be appropriate in their original form. Radio versions or changed lyrics to songs that are inappropriate will not be accepted.
**The show coordinator reserves the right to deem any performance inappropriate and decisions on acceptability for a school performance are final.*
- 3.) If applicable, students are responsible for providing the music for their performance. If they are singing, the karaoke (no vocals) version of the song they are performing is required. This must be turned in with the permission slip. Failure to provide the necessary music with the permission slip (both due by 4/20/17) will result in the student not being able to participate.
- 4.) A student may be dismissed from the show for any of the following reasons:
 - Not having a close to “show-ready” performance at the first practice. Practice performance must clearly demonstrate evidence of at-home rehearsing.
 - Failing to continue to meet the extra-curricular eligibility requirements in the CCS Code of Conduct.
 - Failing to follow the CCS Code of Conduct at all tryouts, practices, and at the show.
 - Missing a practice.
