



2016-2017 Uniform Scholarship Lottery

The goal of the CCSHSA Uniform Scholarship program is to provide financial aid to families to help subsidize the cost of the school uniform.

- 2016-2017 Uniform Scholarships will be awarded via a lottery.
- These scholarships are only available to students who qualify for the *Federal Free or Reduced Meals Program*.
- To be included in the lottery, there must be a determination reached based on the properly completed meal application or confirmation of an indicated *Direct Certification* status showing students are eligible for free or reduced priced meals.
 - To be included, properly completed meal applications must be received by Collegium on or before Thursday, September 22, 2016.
 - Families receiving *Notification of Predetermined Eligibility (Direct Certification)* on or before Monday, September 26, 2016 will automatically be included in the lottery.
- Scholarships will be distributed as gift certificates to *Flynn and O'Hara* (CCS's uniform supplier).
- Families with outstanding obligations to Collegium (from either a current CCS student or a previously enrolled student) will not be considered for these scholarships. Please address obligations immediately to ensure eligibility for the lottery.
- Families submitting incomplete or late meal applications (after Thursday, September 22, 2016) may not be considered for these scholarships and therefore not included in the lottery.
- The process of awarding scholarships will occur via a lottery to be held on or near Thursday, October 6, 2016.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified by November 4, 2016 via first-class mail to the address of record for the student.
